


Driving and Angina









Need not notify the DVLA

X - Must not drive when symptoms occur:



at rest

with emotion a

at the wheel

X - Must notify the DVLA.



Must not drive when symptoms occur.

May be relicensed/licensed



Driving may resume after satisfactory symptom control.

- (provided there is no other
- disqualifying condition) if:
- no angina for at least 6 weeks
- the requirements for exercise or other functional tests as requested by the DVLA can be met.
